

## TRIAL PERIOD BETWEEN TWO CHURCHES

Our Call Committee and Council recently had a meeting with Pastor Miller of the Upper Susquehanna Synod to discuss where we are in this process. In this meeting, it was also discussed about the possibility of Father Fred Stevenson of Christ Episcopal conducting services every Sunday here at Good Shepherd then immediately going to Christ Church for their services.

On Friday, August 14, a Zoom Meeting was held between our Synod, the Diocese, Fr. Fred and Stephanie. The end result of this meeting was that our Call Process will be put on hold and that we would do a **trial month for September only**, wherein Good Shepherd would change their start time to 8:45 instead of 9:00 allowing time for Fr. Fred to complete our service and then go to Christ Episcopal. Then in October, we would go back to our regular time of 9:00 and Christ Episcopal would change their time from 9:30 to 9:45.

After the trial period, a meeting will be held by both churches to discuss the feelings of both congregations.

Please remember, this is only a trial period. So, at the end of September if you should have an opinion regarding the time change, please let President Stephanie or a member of the church council know of your feelings.
